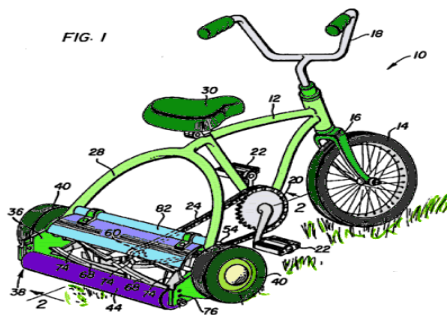
Presidents report - By Lex

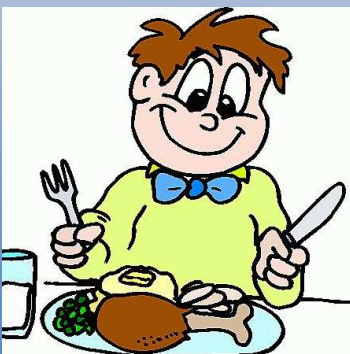
