Remit procedure:

- 1. Record proposer and seconder and that remit is therefore valid.
- 2. All speakers will be given one minute each.
- 3. Proposer address to the remit
- 4. Speakers for and against the remit [one opportunity per person, not including the proposer]. Number of speakers limited at president/chairperson's direction.
- 5. Proposer's right of reply/opportunity to amend remit.
- 6. Put motion/vote.

Any changes have to be registered on the Government of NZ Companies Office and Charities Commission. The Constitution and Bylaws is a legal document.

Page 4 of the WOS Constitution states: "This constitution is intended to be regarded as an agreement of Honour, interpreted according to the spirit as well as the letter of its provision'.
