The underlying professionalism did of course prevail and the high quality results are there for all to see in the presentation of the grounds and facilities at our Waikato holiday home we love to share with you all.


I cannot envisage a better way to escape from the stress of the working week by coming to the WOS working bee and sharing happy times with such nice people - & the entertainment was all free!!
