Charles Whipple - part of WOS Matangi History.

Charlie lived at WOS while he was building his dream boat 'Resolution' for his intended round the world solo voyage. He was also a 'writer in residence' publishing several of his western books. Some of the characters bear the names of WOS members. Read them and find out 'who.'

John W a boat designer and WOS member [later a president] guided Charlie through the boats construction, which took 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ years.

In 2005 -Charlie rented the tiny WOS caravan before buying his own small caravan. His book 'Ship of Dreams' describes the building of the boat with several references to his time at WOS. Of special interest

pages 33,34 and 45, 62 talks about WOS and several of the members.

Other references are mentioned throughout the book.

In 2006 an accident with the bench saw his left index finger and part of his thumb cut off. Undaunted he carried on building.


Charlie, an American by birth, had lived in Japan for many years with his Japanese wife. She came out to NZ for a short time also staying at WOS.

In 2008 Chalie set sail with several WOS members waving him fare well, little expecting to see him featuring on the TV news the next day.

A mayday call was received off Great Barrier and Charlie was winched off

a rock. In his words: "Boat Break, Dream Break, Heart Break".

Charlie died in 2020 but he and his books remain part of WOS history.








Cor has created great things in the office with these handy shelves.

BOOKINGS:-


