

WOS member Brian has finally been paired up with a fully trained and registered guide dog from <u>Blind Low Vision NZ Guide Dogs.</u>

For many years Brian has lived with a creeping and inoperable affliction of both eyes to the stage that now the impairment seriously affects his remaining vision.

I believe you and I would simply consider ourselves blind if we were at the at the stage he is, however he does not see eye to eye with us on that view as he actively gets on with life by improvising and using determination plus innovation to manage day to day life seemingly hassle free.

This is of course an illusion-he can see bugga all these days but

over time his now finely tuned other senses and his "can do " attitude offers us the liberty to easily "forget" his impairment when we are looking through our rose coloured glasses.

Brian and his lovely wife Anna recently received notification that the NZ Guide dog people had a possible match for him with a trained dog and that he was to go to Auckland for an intensive two weeks training with this very special dog'Flynn" to see if they could indeed meet the criteria of becoming a "working match" together.

There followed an array of complex tests and exams under exacting scruti-



ny and then after two weeks training together the experts declared that Flynn and Brian were indeed a match and Flynn became a member of the household in July 2023 and of course by law in New Zealand Flynn the registered guide dog has the right to accompany Brian wherever he goes even on "No dogs allowed" zones in this country.

Hi all


We have decided to create a private WOS Facebook page. This will be for current members only and shouldn't be visible to others. Of course all Facebook rules will need to be followed.

BOOKINGS:-




